

New Members:

Minutes from last Meeting. The minutes from the last meeting were read by members present, Moved by Jeanette Monds second by Daniel Inglis that they be true and correct.

Treasurers Report: There was no treasurers report to night, as Phil was away.

Business Arising. Breakup for 2012, and Track discussion more in general business.

Delegates Report: The delegates report/s was given by Graeme Monds.

State President: TV show – Supercar showdown. Karting part of the program was filmed at Todd Road. Thanks to Go Kart club for the use of their facility.

Come n try karts – these are now fixed and will be back at the next Council meeting.

State Treasurer: Phil presented the financial report to the delegates present.

Junior Development camp – Phil to look into the term deposit and payment from each open entry as this was agreed sometime ago to help build up the Junior development funds for the future.

State Technical: Discussion in regards to a few items that are going to be dealt with at the Technical conference in a few weeks time.

State Scrutineer: Country series Round 3, Wimmera Kartway 19th & 20th May.

A Restricted light kart had 7kg of lead in a stainless steel box in front of the radiator (Leopard 125) the box was mounted on the frame, with 6mm bolts and also 6mm bolts holding the lid on. Was told to remove the box and fit the weight as per the rule book.

We had two rota seals come apart, 1 as we were fitting it and the other on the track.

North West Titles, Mildura Kart Club, 9th & 10th June.

About a dozen exhaust wires not fitted, we need to keep a better eye on this problem, or perhaps warn them at drivers brief.

We had two cameras come off the karts on the track, they didn't have multi strand wires, perhaps we need to Reword the rule and say all cameras need the multi strand wire, the weight in the rule book might confuse people.

Rule 25.31 Cameras on karts:

4. The camera (if over 100 gms) itself must be secured to the kart using a multi strand tether wire or cable ties securely attached to the camera and an adjacent tie point on the kart chassis.
