**Minutes from last Meeting.** The minutes from the 2015 AGM were read by member's present, moved by Tony Correa and second by Grant Wicks that they be true and correct.

**Treasurers Report:** Phil gave his report, the report was read by member's present, Phil also mentioned in his report that there was a significant saving on track maintenance

expenditure, this is solely due to the generosity of the Correa family in donating to the club the cost of the fuel.

Asset purchases made during the year totalled \$4,605, but were valued at a lot more than the cost.

The main items paid for were the lap score board, new cash register and sprucing up the trailer.

The largest project carried out this year was the extension of the tech shed to provide a better and safer working environment. This cost of this project came in at a staggeringly low amount of \$812. The reason for this was due to the efforts of Brett and Peter Morrow in procuring the Materials needed from Steeline at no cost, and of the great work and "elbow grease of Shannon Bright, John Schena. Peter Aitken and Mr. Pollard doing the construction. Thank you all, greatly appreciated.

**Club days:** There has been a trend now over the past three years where we have seen a decline in

average entry numbers in each six-month period.

**Membership numbers:**

- Member numbers as at 30<sup>th</sup> June 2016 stood at 155. (157 at 30<sup>th</sup> June 2015.
- Licensed members who have nominated us as their home club stand at 55. [A word of caution...](#)  
If we drop below 50, the club will be reduced to one vote at delegates' meetings and one open meeting on the calendar (KV Calender Policy). These numbers have steadily declined: 2015 – 70.  
2014 – 89. We are sure that we do not want to lose our voting numbers nor our open, so please think about it.
