# President's Report.

Hello All

2017 is here and we are off and running, our Newsletter (for March) out for you all to get up to date with some of the club activities going on.

First of all, a sign off from last year with the Christmas party going well and thank you to those that made it happen. The lead up to Christmas with all the decorations (thanks Kelsee) made it feel that Christmas was not far away (I apologise for not being there but holiday booking made before August). You all would have noticed the progress with the Tyre changeout with the next major job turn one.

**Two** when we enter the pit area we are going to have all drivers stay in their karts until the Scale Marshal tells you to get out of your karts.

**Three** because of the red line starting procedure we are going to do what we used to do whereas, the Grid Marshall will indicate for all drivers to start, once started raise your hand, then the Grid Marshall will release you onto the track collectively. This format will be in use as of March Club day.

Couple of exciting things to look forward to coming up is the Round 3 Golden Power Series May 6-7<sup>th</sup> and the C&D Grade Titles August 5-6<sup>th</sup> (which we are looking at having under lights!!!). These are our two opens and in which I encourage you all to enter so gain more experience to better your racecraft especially with the bigger fields. If you do not enter still be around to watch and learn or even put your hand up and assist us in running the events.

A bring a mate program is being looked at for May 27<sup>th</sup> saturday (dependant on your interest) details to follow. Some ideas have been tossed around on the social front where we can get together other than race day. Have a 35<sup>th</sup> Year Reunion pencilled in June 10<sup>th</sup>, late last year a trivia night was suggested so we will look at that (Grant).
