Note to all clubs – that if they wish to do any changes they must notify the state to get the approval from the State track inspector.

Mildura Kart Club: Re Victorian State Cup rotation. Agenda items: 1.

That all eligible Victorian Clubs go on a roster system for the hosting of the Victorian State

That all clubs who are eligible reserve their right to decline the event and the opportunity go to the next club on the list.

That clubs have the infrastructure in place to be eligible to run the event and the venue be inspected 6 weeks beforehand and all infrastructure be completed at the time of that inspection. The cost of that inspection be covered by that host club.

The clubs that presently host the Australian Karting Championship or the State Championship are ineligible to host this event.

That clubs will only be eligible to host the event every 5 years, unless the previous club on the roster declines to run the event

The precedent has now been set with the State Championship being placed on a roster and we believe it is now time for the Victorian State Cup to be placed on a roster system as well Discussion and some questions on the above submission.

Clubs agreed but would like to have the process thought through and put on paper this needs to be discussed at a face to face meeting in February to put together the Criteria set for the holding of this event, Makeup of the club Roster.

Criteria for this event will need to go into the state series regs.

That the Victorian State Cup go on a Roster system.

That any club that is holding an AKC or Pro Tour event they are ineligible to hold this event.
