With threatening weather forecast for the weekend, an influx of late entries didn't happen. However, the rain held off allowing dry, fast racing in all classes for the 62 entrants who did support the event.

KA4 Junior Light

Local driver Bailey Collins showed his speed, class & local knowledge to put on a superb driving exhibition, qualifying fastest and winning all but one of the races, Nigel Laity getting up for the win in heat 2. Collins also re-set the lap record on the last lap of the final with time of 30.086.

Cadet 9

Seven drivers took to the grid in this class with five of them being new to racing "P" plate drivers for the weekend of racing. Young Cadel Ambrose showed his class taking a clean sweep of qualifying & all the races.

Tony Manson from KA requested an investigation into a photo that he had seen in regards to a kart being airborne at the Vic. Championships.

Telephone hook-up with the Track Safety Committee:

One thing to come out of the meeting was that KA want clubs to have a place at all circuits the new warning sign as per the National Track Construction and Safety Guidelines. Rule 29.1. There must be two of them 1.8 x 1.2 metres. KA were going to look at providing these signs to each club but that has not occurred.

I believe that the Victoria State Government are currently offering safety grants so that may be something that clubs can look at.

Agenda Items:

1. Child Safe policy – signed document is still required from each club. Once received a meeting will be held to assist the officer with their duties and what is required of them.
