

State Tech. Coordinadtor: Training day went well. We showed them how to put seals etc on also how to write out the penalty and technical inspectors forms. Then a slide show presentation of scrutineering situations and other technical /scrutineers.

State Track Inspector: Main thing at the moment is the warning sign MUST be at the front gate at every circuit. Karting Australia has sent out sticker sign to every club in Victoria. Clubs are required to have two signs as there has to be one at every entrance of the facility. Refer to document from Tony Manson.

Clubs to have a private practice sign that entails a whole lot of information read appendix 1 in the KA Manual. A sign needs to be put at the out grid.

Sign in book needs to be in a place so that everyone can sign it at all private practice. This includes the day prior to a race day.

Clubs could use the \$600.00 to fix up all safety signs.
