

**Minutes from last Meeting.** The minutes from the November meeting were read by members present, Moved by Russell frost second by Glenn Wall that they be true and correct.

**Treasurers Report.** Treasurer gave his report to the members present, the report was Moved by Lorraine Aitken and Second by Russell Frost.

**Delegates Report:** The delegates report was given by Andrew Broadbent. Andrew reported from the delegates meeting which was held 8<sup>th</sup> March, was a hook up for the delegates.

Comments from the Executive Commission report attended by Russell White.

Clubs Driver Rankings (CDR) are to be listed on Supp Regs and in Mylaps.

Need to find out how this is achieved??

Option tyre is under discussion. No firm decisions as yet. It is assumed that the choice of an Óption' tyre Is a harder tyre for club days which will last longer.

There may be a proposed meeting with Club Presidents and a representative from KA, possibly the KA.CEO.

A robust discussion around the drop in "race" licence numbers. There is a discrepancy between the licence numbers detailed by KA and the numbers detailed from VKA, due to the timing when the figures are taken during the year.

KA are also discussing a "Plus 1 Project" which is a plan to try and increase membership by 1 member per month. KIA can provide some small scale funding to run programs aimed at improving club membership.

The Vic State Executive will have a meeting in the near future to discuss possible options that can be undertaken to try and increase licence numbers at club level.

Several clubs raised concern about the 2 sets of Rules for Cadet 9, with respect to magnesium rims, electronic aides, spark plugs, axles, gearing etc. This was in response to comments back to the clubs from it's members. There were comments about additional cost to karters to comply with both sets of rules for club days and State cup meetings. Also the difficulty in administering and inspecting the regulations. It was considered that there are too many rules for Cadet 9.

Any new rules to be considered need to be submitted to Karting Victoria by 0<sup>th</sup> April as the cut off date.

It has been proposed that the new rules for Cadet 9 be dropped or modified as being one of the submissions for a new rule change.

Voting to remove 'TAG 125 Masters' and replace with 'Victorian Combined Masters' at the Victorian State

Championships round 1, was carried out. The result was in favour of the change.
