Minutes from last Meeting. The minutes from the November meeting were read by members present, Moved by Glenn Wall second by Geoff Medew that they be true and correct.

Treasurers Report. No treasurers report. Treasurer was absent.

Business Arising. NIL

Delegates Report: The delegates report was given by Andrew Broadbent. Andrew reported from the delegates meeting which was held 12th May, 2018 was a hook up for the delegates.

State President/Executive Commissioner.

Cadet 9 class new rule - Telephone discussion with Kelvin O'Reilly (KA CEO) he asked what would the State like KA to do? It was requested that they look at taking out the rule altogether. KA to make an announcement in regards to tyres on the option for meeting below state and National Championships.

These tyres are for club days and open meetings. State have seen no data as yet to decide what is best.

Track Safety Grants are open until the end of the month. Up to 50,000.00 this grant is not guaranteed by the states. Clubs need to put in for these asap.

Congratulations to the Geelong Kart Club the facilities and members the track and pits were presented professionally and a well-run event the Victorian Kart Championships round 1.

State Technical Coordinator: No issues at the moment.

Technical inspection there was no problems at the VKC.

State Scrutineering Coordinator: Numbers need to be able to be read from about 20 metres. Safety wire needs to be on the exhaust and cameras.

State Track Inspector: It has been noted at a couple tracks that the tyres should be a bundle of 600mm X 4 wide secured properly.

Track inspections to be conducted within the next few months.

General Business:

Goulburn Valley: Two day meeting for the Australasian Kart Titles please change the website calendar to reflect that it is two days. The red plate will still be on offer as per all previous years.

The club is having computer issues with Orbits.

Eastern Lions: Asked on allowing parents to go out on the track when the Cadet 9 and Cadet 12 are out.

This can be done the officials can request if parents wish to go out. Officials need to explain to the parents however that they are there for all drivers not just their own kids.

Rochester: The two spark plugs that have to be used for the Cadet 9 class, the one specified will not fit a corner engine only a vortex.

Portland: Asked if the reimbursement of the safety signs will be extended. KV executive will look into this. Portland has forwarded an email explaining they are missing a safety sign to it will be a bit later.

New Licence applications using CMS:

All new licences the way they are being done at the present by KA it has taken out of personal contact with clubs. Licence secretaries cannot just apply for a licence now, which makes it a bit hard to know what equipment etc. they have and who has joined the club.

The way it works: The application goes to the club with payment of the club membership once the club acknowledges the membership application then they approve the temporary licence which then goes to the state for processing.

Many clubs are not allowing an automatic entry to their club, the application has to be approved and need to meet with the club licence officer to get key and sign up the membership forms etc.
