## President's Report.

Hello All

Well the weather definitely was a mixture for the Friday, Saturday and Sunday of the Power Series round 4 for the start of the month. Everyone seemed to enjoy the competition that having more drivers and karts circulating brings. Club members featured well in the results so well done to all. A big thanks to all the Volunteers both as Officials and Club / Canteen support and helpers.

Now before we move on I have a couple of things to bring up from the meeting firstly and not necessarily in order is the observation of both Flags and Flag point Lights. If you are not aware, a penalty can be enforced for failing to observe and that is for all flags including the checkered.

Unfortunately, and very disappointing for me there was an incident on that weekend which brought to my attention some ugly and inexcusable behaviour. I am not going to name people here but I am going to state that we as a club have Model Rules and intend to enforce should this behaviour continue. Yellow Light observation and incident.

\*\*\*Yellow Flag point Light wording taken straight from the rules:

d) Yellow: (Waved) A waved Yellow Flag / flashing yellow light is the signal of danger ahead. Reduce your speed, do not overtake and be prepared to change direction. There is a hazard ahead. Overtaking is not permitted between the first yellow flag / light and the next until an operational flag point that is not displaying a yellow flag/light. has been passed. To assist following Competitors and if it can be done with safety a Competitor should raise one arm to indicate that the Driver is slowing for the yellow flag. Failure to slow to a safe speed for a yellow flag will be considered a serious breach of these Rules.

REDUCE YOUR SPEED, DO NOT OVERTAKE AND BE PREPARED TO CHANGE DIRECTION is the big take away from this rule.

I am still not going to name people here but the other is Abuse to our own Members that are in Official Positions. If people are not happy and wish to voice their opinion or frustration the ONLY two people you need to talk to is the Chief Steward or the Clerk of Course of the meeting. Find out who they are if you don't know!!!!

Also a reminder that any breach of the rules by family or pit crew can be associated to the respective driver.

Firstly, people can be charged under the AKA General Rules Chapter 8 Section 5 m) Intimidation, Abuse & Threats

(i) A person must not by words, acts, or omissions abuse, intimidate, abuse or threaten any other person.

Recommended Minimum Penalties (General)

**Intimidation, Abuse and Threats** General Rules Chapter 8 Rule 5 m) Exclusion from the Meeting plus referral to a disciplinary tribunal with a recommendation for a 3 month suspension.

**\*\*\*Intimidation, Abuse and Threats of an Official** General Rules Chapter 8 Rule 5 m) Exclusion from the Meeting plus referral to a disciplinary tribunal with a recommendation for a 6 month suspension.

These people are volunteers and do not deserve any of this and without them you will not race.

Secondly and apart from this the club will enforce its own – NO-TOLERANCE – so officially this is the last warning to all and any acts in future will be followed with a letter.

We as a club do not need this behaviour, I hope that we can continue to build and enjoy our club, strengthen our friendships and have somewhere we can all enjoy.

Following July Club Day on August 18/19 weekend we have our final open being the C&D Grade Titles which you all need to get your entries in early so as to help Lorraine and the Club prepare, with an idea of numbers for catering.

Now speaking of Catering Kelsee has asked to change things for the Saturday Night 18<sup>th</sup> Aug. so instead of the Spit Roast it will be a Pizza and Pasta (with desert as well) details to come out on Facebook.

Now I mentioned last month that the Trivia Night social event September 15<sup>th</sup> Saturday is the date so unless I hear otherwise July club day that will be the locked in date. Put that in your calendar. It is a professional run event with Auction and Games so please support – Full details will be out on Facebook. (Good on you Curt).

**New Members:** NIL.

**Minutes from last Meeting.** The minutes from the November meeting were read by members present, moved by Glenn Wall second by Geoff Medew that they be true and correct.

**Treasurers Report:** Treasurer was away, no report.

**Business Arising:** Cameras. Tony going to see when they available. Club pay for them, then they will be installed.

**Delegates Report:** The delegates report was given by Andrew Broadbent. Andrew reported from the delegates meeting which was held 12<sup>th</sup> June 2018 was a hook up for the delegates.

State President/ Executive Commissioner Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> June Clubs Presidents meeting with KA CEO Kelvin O'Reilly, Lee Hanatschek Phil Smith and Vice President of KV. Adam Bourke Russell White in the Timing meeting as he is the only timing officer for South West, all clubs presidents attended except 2.

The Timing accreditation went well and the timing officers attending learnt a lot. Every club attended except 2.

The presidents meeting: The plus 1 meeting documentation had not been sent out to clubs as the front-page instruction from KA was not for publication.

Russell is now on the rule review panel for Karting Australia.

**State Scrutineering Coordinator:**

Parents/pit crew must make sure that the karts are mechanically safe for the Juniors/Cadets.

Cadet 9 spark plug not available at this present time. There is a replacement spark plug available.

**State Track Inspector:**

Couple of tracks have been inspected and approved. Clubs must maintain normal maintenance and must be completed at all times – not prior to a track inspection.

**Agenda items:**

Oakleigh Delegate: The state may need to go with changes in regards to changing the last Sunday of the month for club days. This was discussed at the KA club presidents meeting, also about having large meetings just prior to a National event held in our state.

How do we value our club days?

Many meetings too close together.

Practice for the open meetings a week prior to the event?

Karter's not having the funds to do all events and they pick a series etc to run. The don't run club days.

As per discussions at the presidents meeting KA have a tentative 2019 Calendar put together and they have said the States are required to set calendar around KA's events.

Trevor Crane offered to have a go at producing a race calendar.
