

General Meeting. 07/08/2018.

The general meeting of the Gippsland Go-Karts was held at our clubrooms, on Tuesday 7th August, 2018 and was declared opened at 7.05 pm by President Peter Richards.

Apologies: Jeanette Monds, Lynda Richards & Phil Lane.

New Members: To our new members who have just joined WELCOME. Our new members are Richard Wood Leigh Everitt, Ryan & Rory Knight, we all hope that you enjoy yourselves with us.

Minutes from last Meeting. The minutes from the November meeting were read by members present, moved by Lorraine Aitken second by Peter Aitken that they be true and correct.

Treasurers Report: There was no treasurers report tonight, Phil was absent, and he is taking leave from the treasurer's job for personnel reasons.

Business Arising: NIL

Delegates Report: The delegates report was given by Andrew Broadbent. Andrew reported from the delegates meeting which was held 12th June 2018 was a hook up for the delegates.

Treasurers Financial Report:

A revised Profit and loss sheet to be re sent out to the delegates.

State President/Executive Commissioner:

Attended the rule review meeting – not many rules changes for 2019.

Officials at club day race meetings – low numbers only require essential officials, but larger club number should have all officials required on club days.

Enduro advertised to be held at GKCV in December - this need to sorted out with clubs and state. It would have been nice to have had a heads up prior to it going on face book and on kartsportsnews.

GKCV to enter a submission to KV for approval by delegates.

State Technical Coordinator:

Competitors Disobeying officials – this needs to be addressed with some penalties being handed out.

Restrictors must be kept clean some competitors had to be told. State Championships was a good meeting.

State Officials Coordinator:

Discussion around Verbal and Written warnings.

They are both reprimands.

State Scrutineering Coordinator:

12.5 Rotax Max 125 Carby slide some found to be incorrect installed. (confirmed correct slide in technical regulations.)

Weights for the TaG parity changed as per below.

TaG 125 IAME X30 –No change

PRD Galaxy – 3kg increase to the minimum weight.

Rotx EVO – 5kg reduction to the minimum weight.

All other eligible engines – No change.

The implementation date will be Monday July 16.

Weight chart for scales area – KV to look into this and send out to clubs. At all race meetings all weights have to be recorded for each class and the club is to store these sheets. Sheet need to list class, kart number the columns for Qualifying, each heat and final for weight to be recorded.

State Track Inspector:

Every track should have a sign in book for private practice some clubs do not have them and they need to make sure they get them at the grid or in a place that can be seen for anyone using their track sign.

Where applicable, the nominated track direction must be followed. Reverse direction can only be run at a permitted meeting.

Agenda items:

KV AGM moved to the 18thOctober, 2018

Russell cannot be in attendance for the 11th October AGM due to being overseas. Motion Carried.

2019 Race calendar discussion.

Delegates only just received them, so they would like to look over it.

Some of the dates need to be checked. Formula $1 - 17/18^{th}$ March 2019.

Version 2, to be developed and sent out to delegates.

GENERAL BUSINESS:

Oakleigh delegate. Clubs need to be aware that there are some Juniors and Seniors have been out practicing may only have been a couple of laps, but this needs to be addressed.

Wimmera: Asked why one of their officials couldn't be signed off after he attended for one day at the Vic State Championships.

Discussion on the procedure of upgrades etc.

Should any trainee grade 4 official wish to attend a meeting they need to contact the club to see if this is possible.

Portland delegate: Victoria's rule changes where they considered by KA?

Yes, they were, all states rules changes were listed on a board and discussed.

Swan Hill delegate: Swan Hill wishes to hold two meetings in 2019 as they had two last year with the GPS and the state cup.

All race meetings are governed by the constitution and the numbers of licence holders at the end of December the previous year. Under 50 - 1 meeting, over 51 - 2 meetings.

Delegates report was moved by Peter Richards and second by Ross Miller.

Correspondence In: Members present read the list of correspondence and asked for special topics

they wanted to know about. The correspondence was moved by Geoff Medew and second by Glenn Wall.

General Business:

Graeme Monds: Start up area. Start up at tents. 10 seconds. Any longer must be in a designated area.
